The Water Threat to U.S. National Security No One in D.C. is Talking About

Washington, D.C. has narrowly avoided several water related disasters in recent years, any one of which could have shut down schools, businesses, Congress, and federal agencies within 24 hours due to the region's lack of a true backup drinking water supply. The city relies entirely on the Potomac-fed Washington Aqueduct, which remains vulnerable to sewage spills, chemical accidents, algal blooms, and sabotage — and there is currently no contingency plan if that water becomes contaminated. A series of near misses, including a major sewage pipe collapse in January 2025, a hazardous train derailment in 2019, and a crippling algal bloom in 2024, have revealed how close the region has come to crisis without spurring major political action. Meanwhile, efforts to secure long-term water resilience — including backup supply studies and critical flood protection infrastructure — remain underfunded, stalled, or blocked by federal policy decisions, leaving the capital region exposed to a potentially catastrophic failure.

Water Infrastructure Comes Under Fire as Bahrain Desalination Plant Is Struck Amid Iran War

An Iranian drone strike damaged a desalination plant in Bahrain, escalating concerns that the expanding conflict could increasingly target critical drinking water infrastructure. Bahraini officials accused Tehran of hitting civilian facilities, though water and power services were not disrupted, and Iran claimed the attack was retaliation for an alleged U.S. strike on an Iranian desalination plant. The strike has heightened fears that the war may spill over into the Gulf's vital desalination network, which supplies much of the region's drinking water.

As Energy Star Moves Under DOE, Industry Groups Express Optimism

The Department of Energy and the Environmental Protection Agency have signed an agreement to transfer administration of the Energy Star program to DOE, a move many industry groups say could provide greater stability and better alignment with DOE's product expertise. While groups like AHAM and NEMA are optimistic, the U.S. Green Building Council is urging DOE to be transparent about its plans for managing and funding the program. The transition follows recent uncertainty created by proposed EPA funding cuts and staff reductions that affected Energy Star. Under the agreement, program operations, trademarks, and IT systems will shift to DOE over 90 days, with the arrangement lasting up to 10 years.

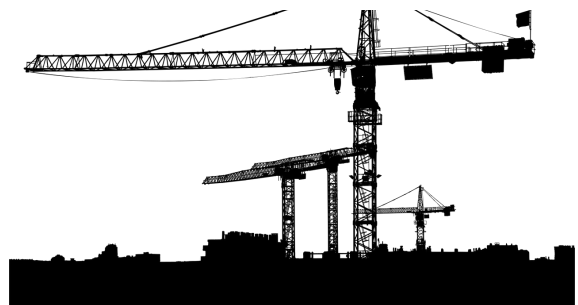
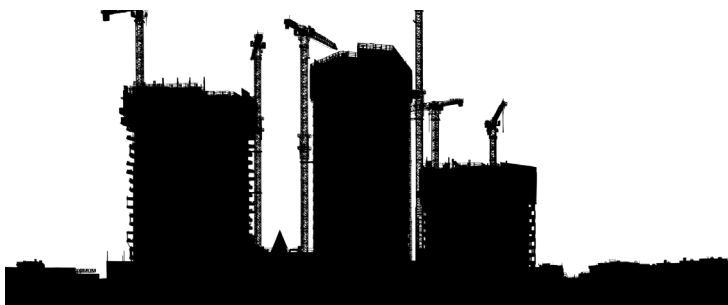

Western States Urge White House to Revise Colorado River Reduction Plan

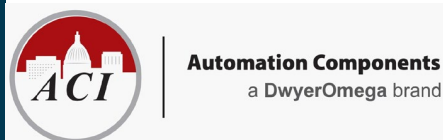
California, Arizona, and Nevada are pushing back against the Trump administration's proposed Colorado River water cuts, arguing the federal options ignore the long standing "Law of the River" and violate the 1922 Colorado River Compact. The three Lower Basin states say the proposals would saddle them with disproportionate reductions while allowing Upper Basin states to avoid responsibility and even increase water use. Upper Basin leaders, meanwhile, argue the federal plans unfairly favor the Lower Basin and fail to reflect the reality of a shrinking river. The growing dispute signals that, if the administration moves ahead with its current approach, the conflict could escalate into a years long legal battle before the U.S. Supreme Court.

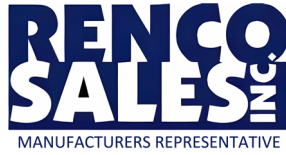

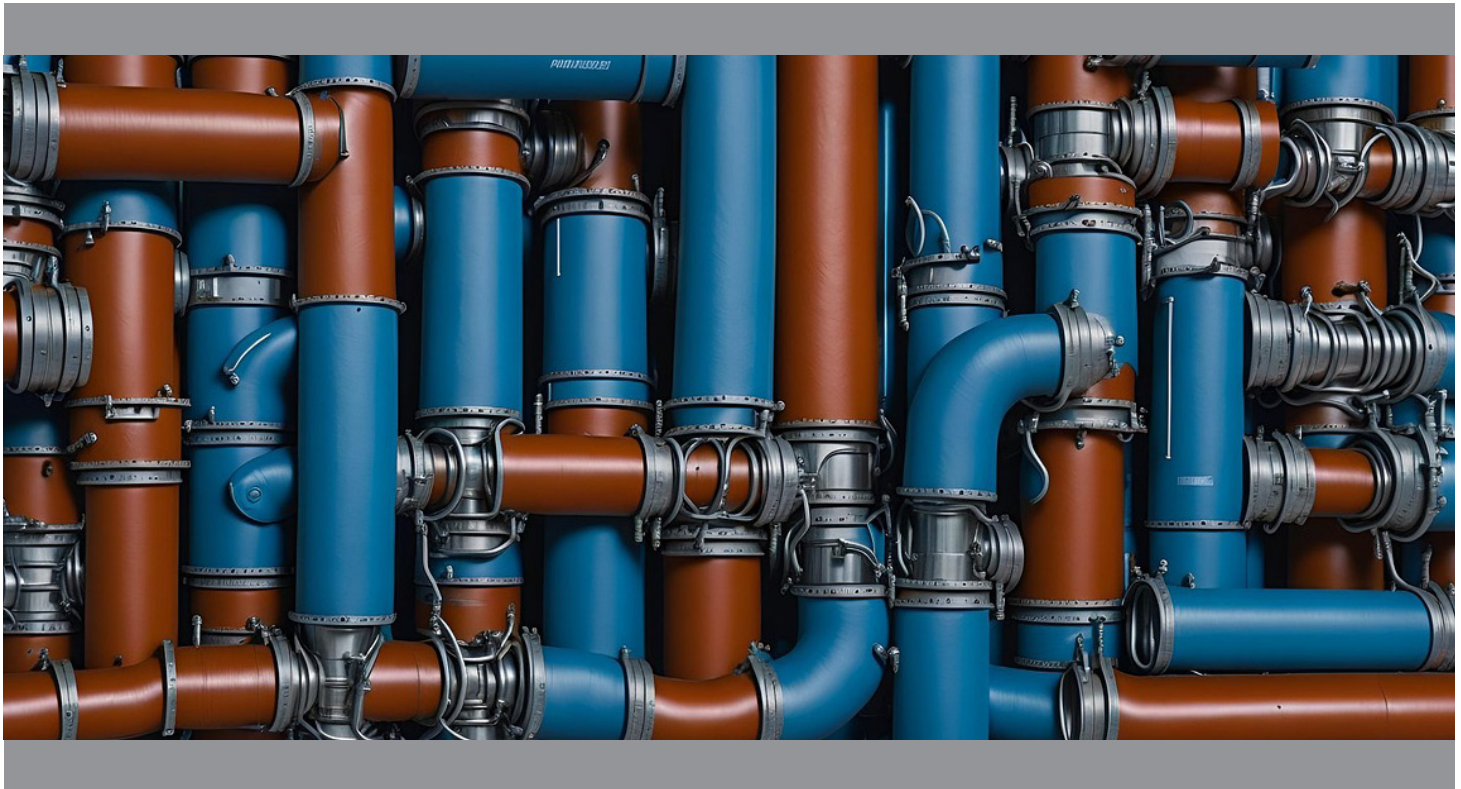

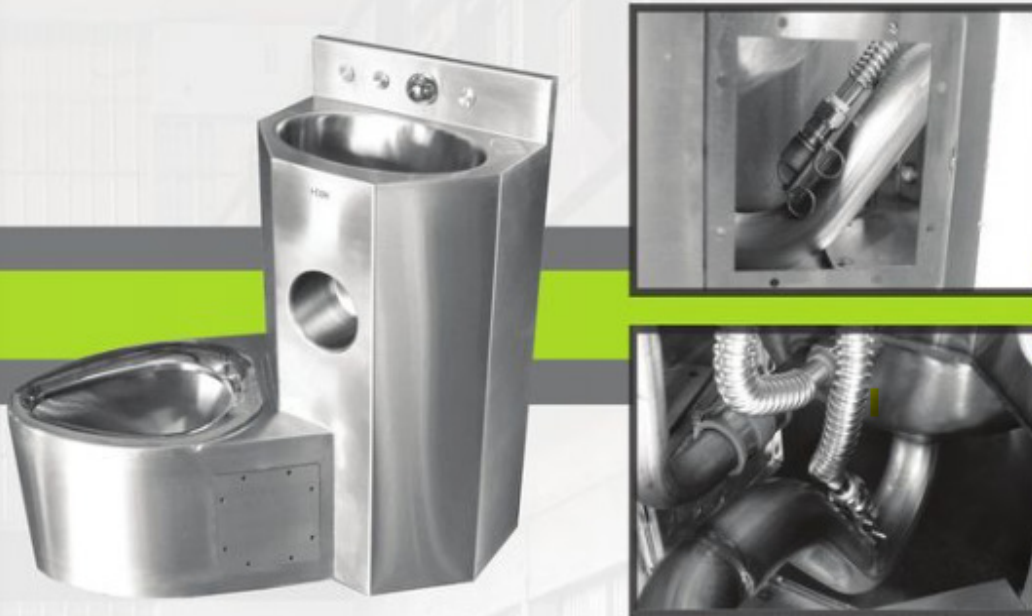
