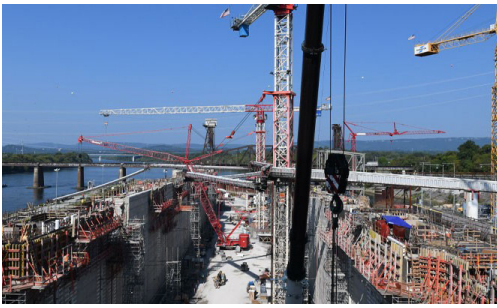

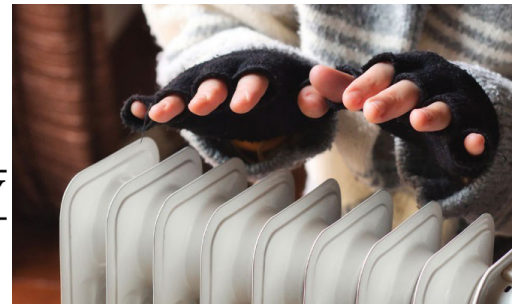

Congress Steers New Earmarks Toward Water and Energy Initiatives

Congress' fiscal 2026 spending bills include more than 8,400 earmarks totaling \$15.7 billion, with some of the largest awards directed to major water infrastructure and hurricane protection projects. After a year without earmarks due to a continuing resolution, lawmakers from both parties are now securing long delayed funding for Army Corps upgrades, dam and lock modernizations, and local water and wastewater systems. The biggest allocations include \$213 million for Tennessee's Chickamauga Lock, \$190 million for Washington state's Hanson Dam project, \$183.8 million for work at the Montgomery Locks and Dam in Pennsylvania, and \$131.5 million for Louisiana's Morganza to the Gulf hurricane protection system. While some fiscal conservatives have criticized the practice, most earmarks are expected to advance as Congress works to finalize the remaining appropriations bills.

New House Caucus Focuses on Energy Affordability and Rising Costs

House Democrats have launched a new Congressional Lowering Utility Bills Caucus aimed at addressing rising electricity and home heating costs. The caucus will pursue legislative solutions as energy affordability becomes a key election year focus. New analysis shows U.S. home heating costs are expected to rise 9.2% this winter, with the average household projected to spend \$995. Advocates warn that these increases disproportionately burden low and moderate income families.

NAHB Calls on Congress to Reduce Regulatory Barriers to Boost Housing Affordability

The National Association of Home Builders told Congress that reducing excessive regulations is essential to addressing the nation's housing affordability crisis. NAHB said regulatory compliance accounts for roughly 25% of the cost of a single family home and more than 40% of the cost of a typical apartment, limiting builders' ability to increase supply. The group urged lawmakers to halt new federal energy code mandates for HUD and USDA financed homes and to ease domestic sourcing and labor requirements that add cost and delays. NAHB said targeted regulatory reforms would help boost production of more affordable homes and apartments.

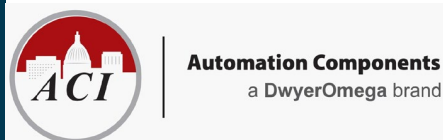
President Issues Executive Order On Rebuilding After Los Angeles Wildfires

President Trump's latest executive order asserts that state and local authorities in California and Los Angeles failed to prevent, manage, and recover from the Pacific Palisades and Eaton Canyon wildfires, leading to prolonged delays in rebuilding. The order directs FEMA and the SBA to consider regulations that would preempt obstructive state and local permitting processes and allow federally funded reconstruction to proceed more rapidly. It also instructs federal agencies to expedite environmental and regulatory reviews, propose new legislation to address future state level recovery failures, and conduct audits into California's use of nearly \$3 billion in hazard mitigation funds. Overall, the order aims to ensure that federal disaster assistance is used swiftly and effectively when state or local governments impede recovery.

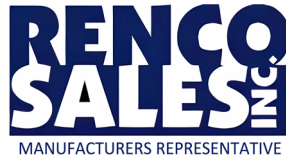

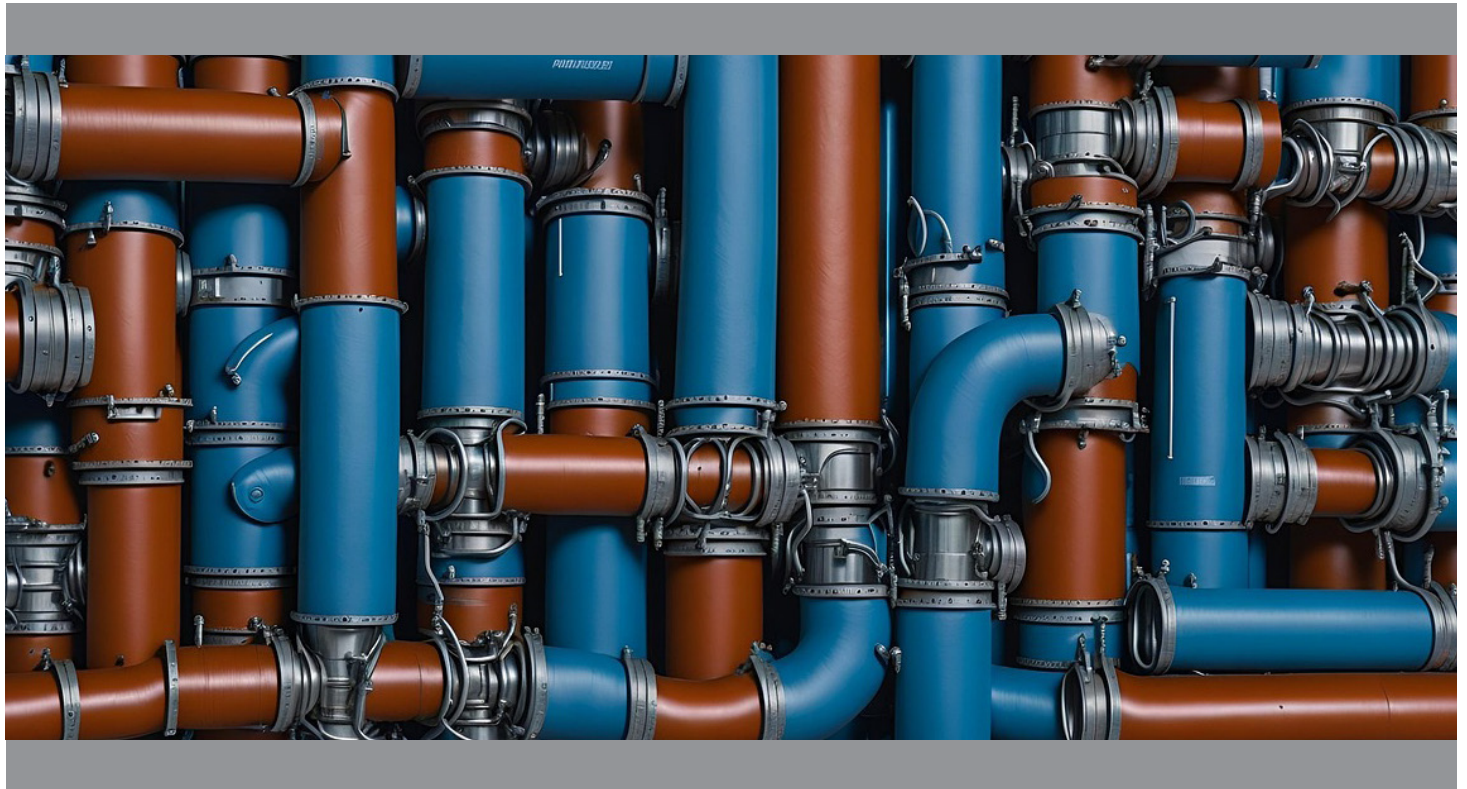
